Agreement of Cooperation №03/02

Udine 03.01.2022

La Civica Accademia d'Arte Drammatica Nico Pepe – Largo Ospedale Vecchio, 10/2 - 33100 Udine Italia (**The School**), represented by Director and President Claudio de Maglio who acts according to its Bylaws and Kyiv Municipal Academy of Circus and performing Arts (**The Institute**), represented by the Rector Oleksandr Yakovlev, who acts according to the Charter, both named **Parties**, acting on the premise that according to the Italian Law about higher educational establishments have the right to realize international collaboration in the sphere of higher education, additional (including professional) education, teaching and creative activities by means of direct treaties concluded by higher educational establishments with foreign juridical persons of foreign citizens, taking into account that higher education plays an essential role in the improvement of mutual understanding and in creation of mutual trust between nationals of different countries, taking into account that the diversity of educational systems in Europe is a reflection of its cultural diversity, wishing to give the students an opportunity to use this source of diversity and get, continue or complete their education in the Institute and/or University, thinking that joint realization and recognition of educational programs and courses is an important measure of satisfying society's needs of specialists who possess fundamental knowledge and high creative potential, who are informed about national and worldwide achievements, agreed upon the following.

Article 1

The Parties direct their efforts to the practical collaboration in the sphere of education, teaching and creative activity.

Article 2

The Parties collaborate in realization of educational programs of higher, additional (including professional) education in the areas and specializations which are of mutual interest.

Article 3

The Parties exchange students who are sent to study separate educational courses, which are taught in the educational establishments of the Parties, fully or partially.

Students may be invited to participate in courses recognized the Parties and taught by our teachers at other locations

Article 4

The Parties invite teachers of different disciplines for teaching and specialists in the sphere of education for advisory work.

Article 5

The Parties organize mutual training for teachers.

Article 6

The Parties hold joint programs on the questions of the development of education.

Article 7

The Parties give each other an opportunity to take part in events which have to do with educational activity and are organized by each Party.

Article 8

The Parties exchange the information about international conferences and seminars on the problems of education which are held in their educational establishments and they render assistance in participation in them for both Parties.

Article 9

The order and conditions of the forms of collaboration enlisted in Articles 2-8 are defined by additional agreements which are integral parts of the given agreement.

Article 10

According to the agreement of both Parties the document can be amended.

Article 11

The Parties' obligations and the activity stipulated by the given Agreement are realized in accordance with the Laws and regulations which exist in each country, as far as they can be applied, and with allowance for the opportunities of using the means that they have.

Article 12

This document commences on the day of being signed. It finishes in accordance with the decision of the Parties, which doesn't influence realization of the events started before the termination of the agreement.

This Agreement is made and signed in duplicate in English and Ukraine and both texts are of equal power.
